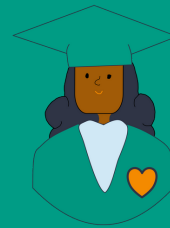

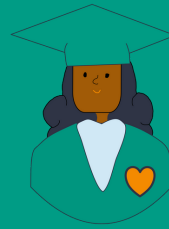

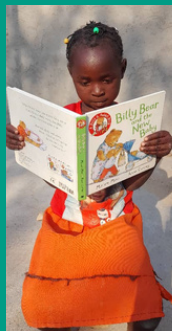

## Our Lasting Legacy - 2024 to early 2025 Improving Literacy & Infrastructure

Book deliveries will continue to support our Read Together programme – at least 20 schools will receive a wheelable library, reading workshops and teacher training to establish lending libraries. Improved literacy has an impact across the whole curriculum!



Additional infrastructure projects will include a 1x3 classroom block at Namabondo Primary School, as well as 10 stances of latrines for pupils and teachers and a 75,000 litre rainwater harvesting tank at Siampondo Primary School. Subject to funding, we also aim to construct a rainwater harvesting tank at Simbunji Primary School.
